



TGS Supports the Following Bills that Would Reduce Gun Violence and Improve Public Safety

House Bills

HB 14 | Rep. Murr

Relating to carrying of handguns by license holders on the property of state hospitals; providing a civil penalty.

HB 111 | Rep. Moody, Joe.

Educational program and fee reductions to improve firearm safety.

HB 191 | Rep. Bernal, Diego.

Relating to the notice given by a property owner prohibiting a handgun license holder from carrying a handgun on certain property.

HB 234 | Rep. Anchia, Rafael.

Relating to wrongful exclusion of handgun license holders from property owned by or leased to a governmental entity and to certain offenses relating to the carrying of handguns on that property.

HB 246 | Rep. Anchia, Rafael

Relating to the notice given by a property owner prohibiting a handgun license owner from carrying a handgun on the property.

HB 255 | Rep. Anchia, Rafael.

Relating to the offense involving the carrying of handguns by license holders on the premises or property of certain recreational facilities.

HB 259 | Rep. Anchia, Rafael.

Requires background checks to be performed for every sale at a gun show.

HB 282 | Rep. Anchia, Rafael.

Allows public universities to opt-out of campus carry.

HB 291 | Rep. Johnson, Eric

Relating to limiting the locations in which a license holder may openly carry a handgun; restricting an exception to a criminal offense.

HB 391 | Rep. Howard, Donna.

Allows public universities to opt-out of campus carry.

HB 392 | Rep. Howard, Donna.

Relating to certain offenses involving the carrying of handguns by license holders on the premises of certain hospitals, mental health facilities, and nursing facilities.

HB 465 | Rep. Anchia, Rafael.

Relating to the prosecution of certain offenses involving the carrying of weapons at amusement parks or locations associated with schools or educational institutions.

HB 466 | Rep. Anchia, Rafael.

Relating to limiting the locations in which a license holder may openly carry a handgun.

HB 631 | Rep. Howard, Donna.

Relating to a public awareness campaign on firearm safety and suicide prevention.

HB 866 | Rep. Moody

Relating to lethal violence protective orders; creating a criminal offense.

HB 899 | Rep. Nevarez

Reduces the size of signs required to be given by a property owner prohibiting a handgun license holder from carrying a handgun on certain property.

HB 1827 | Rep. Hinajosa, Gina

Relating to prohibiting carrying a firearm while intoxicated.

HB 2034 | Rep. Blanco

Relating to requiring a national instant criminal background check for sales conducted over the internet; creating an offense.

HB 2543 | Rep. Nevarez

Relating to the unlawful possession of a firearm by persons who are subject to certain judicial determinations; creating a criminal offense.

HB 2583 | Rep. Martinez, Armando

Relating to prohibiting the reckless discharge of a firearm.

HB 2712 | Rep. Uresti, Thomas

Relating to a firearm buyback program administered by certain local law enforcement agencies.

HB 2880 | Rep. Dutton, Harold

Relating to the criminal punishment for the threatened use of a firearm in or on school property or on a school bus.

HB 3340 | Rep. Thompson, Senfronia

Relating to the provision of information regarding firearm safety and suicide prevention.

HB 4037 | Rep. Anchia, Rafael

Creates a state law that criminalizes straw purchases.

HB 4061 | Rep. Hinajosa, Gina

Relating to the creation of a task force on intentional violent deaths.

HB 4200 | Rep. Hinajosa, Gina

Relating to the acquisition or attempted acquisition of a firearm by a person prohibited from possessing a firearm. Also known as "Lie and Try."

Senate Bills

SB 206 | Sen. West, Royce.

Creates a state law that criminalizes straw purchases.

SB 220 | Sen. Menendez, Jose.

Relating to the offense involving the carrying of handguns by license holders on the premises of certain mental health facilities.

SB 221 | Sen. Menendez, Jose.

Relating to prohibiting the transfer of a firearm to a person listed in the terrorist screening database maintained by the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

SB 222 | Sen. Menendez, Jose.

Relating to designating June as Gun Violence Awareness Month.

SB 434 | Sen. Rodriguez, Jose.

Relating to a lethal violence protective order.

SB 577 | Sen. Nichols

Relating to the offense involving the carrying of handguns by license holders on the premises of state hospitals.

SB 578 | Sen, Lucio, Eddie

Relating to the creation by the Texas Veterans Commission of a veteran suicide prevention plan.

SB 1146 | Sen. Nichols, Robert

Relating to the carrying of handguns by license holders on the property of state hospitals.

SB 1862 | Sen. Lucio, Eddie

Relating to the development of initiatives to reduce veteran suicides in this state.

SB 1960 | Sen. Lucio, Eddie

Creating a task force and a program at the Department of Public Safety for firearms safety, and safe storage.
