



## **TGS Opposes the Following Bills that would Put Public Safety at Risk**

**HB 131 | Rep. Krause, HB 927 | Rep. White, SB 93 | Sen. Hall, SB 450 | Sen. Burton**  
*Creates Exemptions From Federal Regulation of firearms and ammunition.*

**HB 375 | Rep. Stickland and HB 1911 | Rep. White**  
*Removes requirement for Texans who carry a gun in public to obtain a license and training.*

**HB 556 | Rep. Keough** *Makes businesses who prohibit guns on the premises liable for damages in the event the presence of a gun could have prevented the damages, injury or death.*

**HB 560 | Rep. Springer, HB 356 | Rep. Huberty**  
*Expands the carrying of handguns to more areas of school grounds.*

**HB 960 | Rep. Villalba, HB 1313 | Rep. Villalba, SB 444 | Sen. Van Taylor, SB 778 | Sen. Van Taylor** *These bills relate to appointing school marshals who can carry guns at public and private schools, and establishes grant programs.*

**HB 968 | Rep. Metcalf, HB 1915, | Rep. Cain, HB 2105, Rep. Holland, | Sen. Creighton, SB 349 | Sen. Creighton,**  
*Relating to the prosecution of the offense of possessing a weapon in certain prohibited places associated with school or postsecondary educational institutions*

**HB 1945 | Rep. Swanson**  
*Deregulates gun silencers*

**HB 1637 | Rep. Schaefer, SB 449 | Sen. Burton, SB 953, | Sen. Hancock** *Allows people with a license to carry guns in bars.*

**SB 104 | Sen. Hall** *Relating to prohibiting certain physician questions regarding firearms.*

**SB 459 | Sen. Huffines , HB 927 | Rep. White** *Preempts municipal regulation or enforcement of certain firearm laws.*
